Declaration for Children Under Sixteen Years of Age.

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having custody of its Seal, or a Notary Public, or a Justice of the Peace, whose Official Signature shall be verified by his own Official Seal, if he has one, or by the proper Clerk, under Seal.

State of South Carolina County of Colleton, ss:

On this 20th day of August A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety....., personally appeared before me, a Pension Notary within and for the county and State aforesaid, James Jenkins Jr aged 23 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain the pension provided by act of Congress approved June 27, 1890: That he is the legal guardian of Caleb Jenkins

That he left a widow surviving him who died April 6th 1887

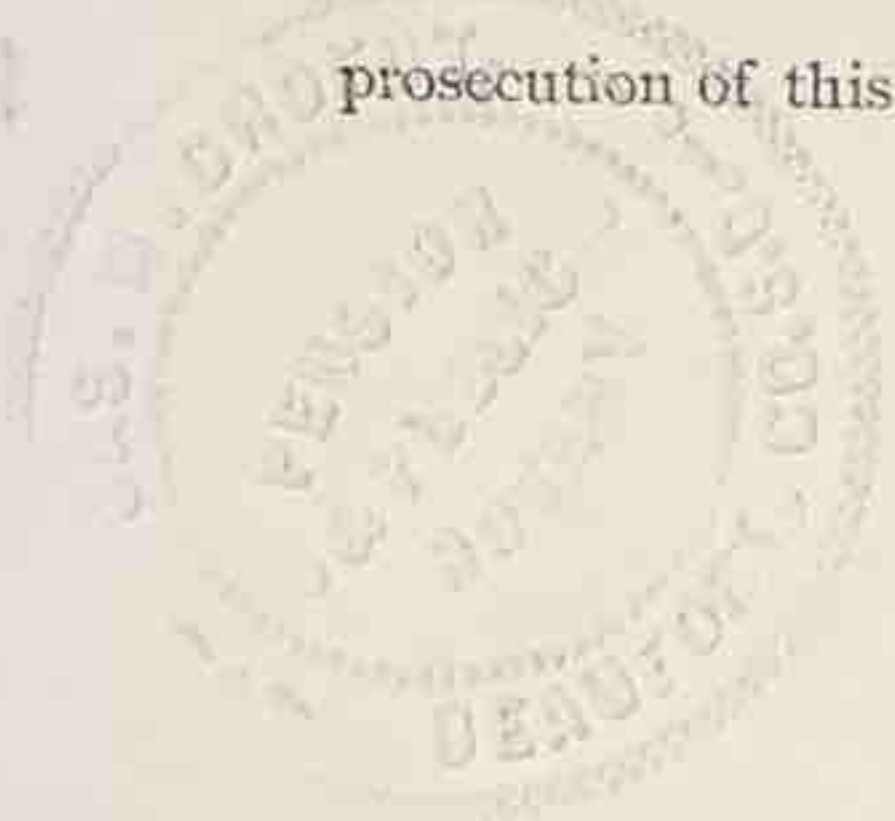

NOTES.

- The Act of June 27, 1890, requires that in minor children's cases:
- (1) That the soldier served at least ninety days in the War of the Rebellion and was *honorably discharged*.
 - (2) Proof of soldier's death (cause need not have been due to Army service), his marriage to mother, and proof of her death or divestment of title.
